



My Life Is a Scenario is a brand-new format that combines reality, talent competition and comedy where ordinary people aspiring to be comedians showcase their talents to the world. And they do it while living in the same house! Who is the most talented actor? Who is the funniest? Who is the most realistic?

Duration:

Weekly, Prime Time





12 contestants previously selected on a national level casting competes every week to find out who the best comedian is. Each episode features 3 types of challenges given by the host and a panel of mentors, all reputable comedians. The contestants will have a natural born sense of humor, with high improvisation and acting skills. They will have to prove it by showing versatility, quickness, believability and most of all, make the audience laugh!

Each mentor picks 3 of the contestants and train them through different challenges. The contestants have to transform into a new character, complete with makeup and costume. They get unusual daily assignments to be performed in and out of the house and be interviewed by the host.

After each challenge, the mentors and the audience will give points to the contestants.

The final show reveals who survived, outperformed and swept everyone off their feet.

The show also focuses on the real personalities of the contestants. Since the contestants are in it for the whole season, their weaknesses and strengths are revealed. Each contestant spends time with the rest of the group and develop personal relationships. We will watch the birth and evolution of friendship, and perhaps of love and rivalry.









FORMAT STRUCTURE / BREAKDOWN

The Mentors and Host

There are 4 mentors who are proven experts and celebrities on their field of acting – each having a different expertise. The host, who is also a renowned comedian is the leader of the show, introducing the contestants and always adding a humoristic tone to the program.

The Challenges

In every episode, there are 3 types of challenges that the contestants will face: character training, directed improvisation in real life situations and live sketches. Some of these challenges are performed individually but there are also some that will require teamwork.

- 1) **Character Training:** The contestants have to become a new person by changing their look, voice and costumes as necessary. They will have to act as realistic as possible in their role, while being trained by their mentors.
- 2) **Directed Improvisation in Real Life:** The contestants are put in the craziest situations that can be imagined and have to act according to the directions of the mentors, over their ear pieces.
- 3) *Live Sketches:* The contestants will perform live with their team a comedy sketch that they have not rehearsed previously. The idea is to see each contestant's skills on quick adaptation and creativity.

















The Weekly Episode, The Finale Gala and The Winner

Each week there is a live gala episode that shows the performances of the contestants during the week. There will also be live performances during the show – the stage will be split into two sections, a section of stage and a section of the interviews and commentaries.

There are no eliminations in the program, the winner is revealed at the final episode.

In each episode, the contestants can earn a maximum of 4 points individually, out of a total of 15 points that will be distributed among them by the panel of mentors. Each mentor will give points to the rival teams' performance, where all the members each earn 1 point. The audience also has a crucial part in the grading: they will vote for the top 3 individual performances.

In the finale gala episode, the points are added up and the winner is revealed.
